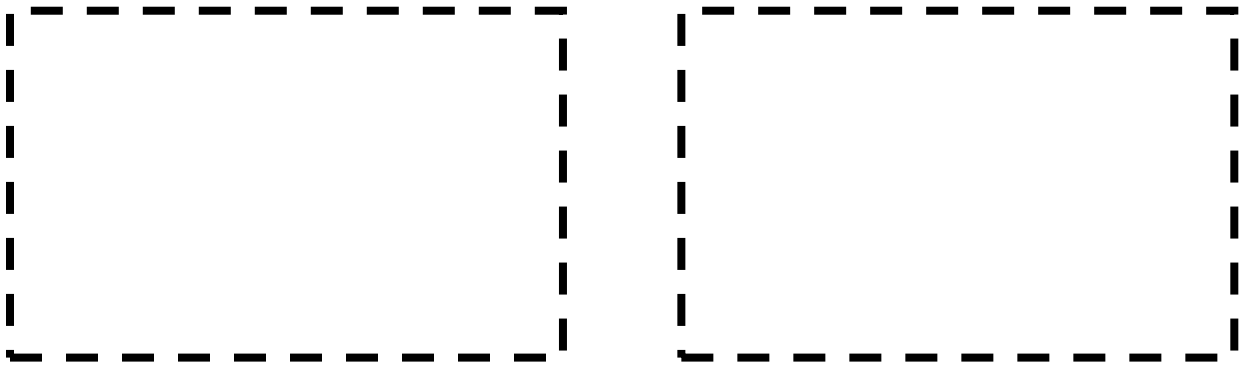


# Jesus and the Temple

**Making the Craft:**

1. In the boxes below draw four pictures: Ruins: the temple destroyed, Temple rebuilt, Jesus on the cross and Jesus alive again.
2. Cut out the dotted lines on this sheet.
3. On the other sheet cut out the two rectangular holes and the two slits.
4. Thread the two long strips through the slits, so that the pictures are behind the other sheet and appear in the holes.
5. Have a go at the other activities on the other sheet.
