

Notes for Parents

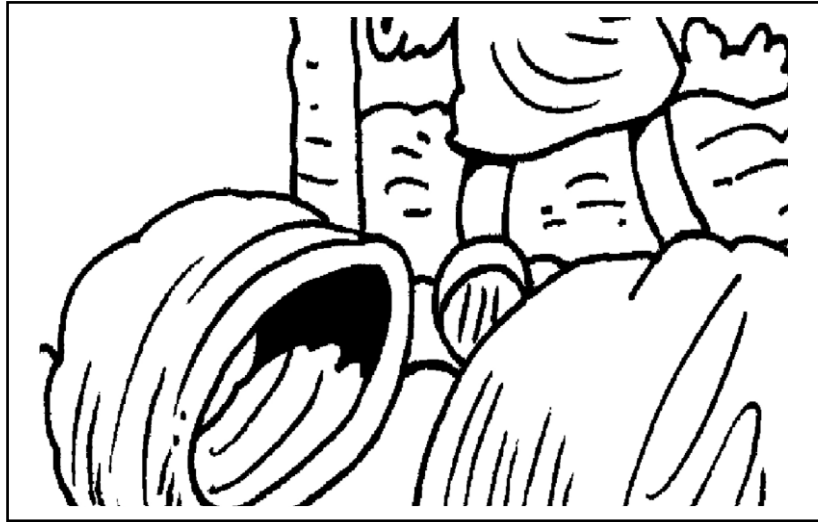
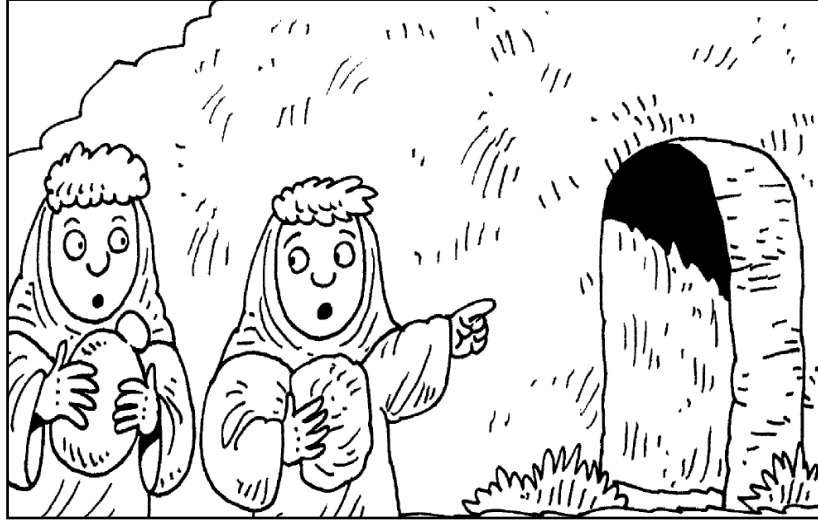
- The first two sheets are for younger children and relate to the talk. For the sheet with the question marks, cut around three sides of each rectangle to create a flap. On the second sheet colour in the pictures. Then stick the first sheet over the second sheet and glue around the edges.
- The flaps should then reveal the four steps towards the disciples solving the mystery of the missing body – Jesus has risen!
- The second two sheets are for older children and are a code system to break the encryption. The greyed-out circle should be cut out and placed above the other circle on the other sheet. Ideally it should be fixed in place with a split pin, but this is not essential. With the circle one way up it makes a happy face to break one part of the code and with the circle the other way up it makes a sad face to break another part of the code.

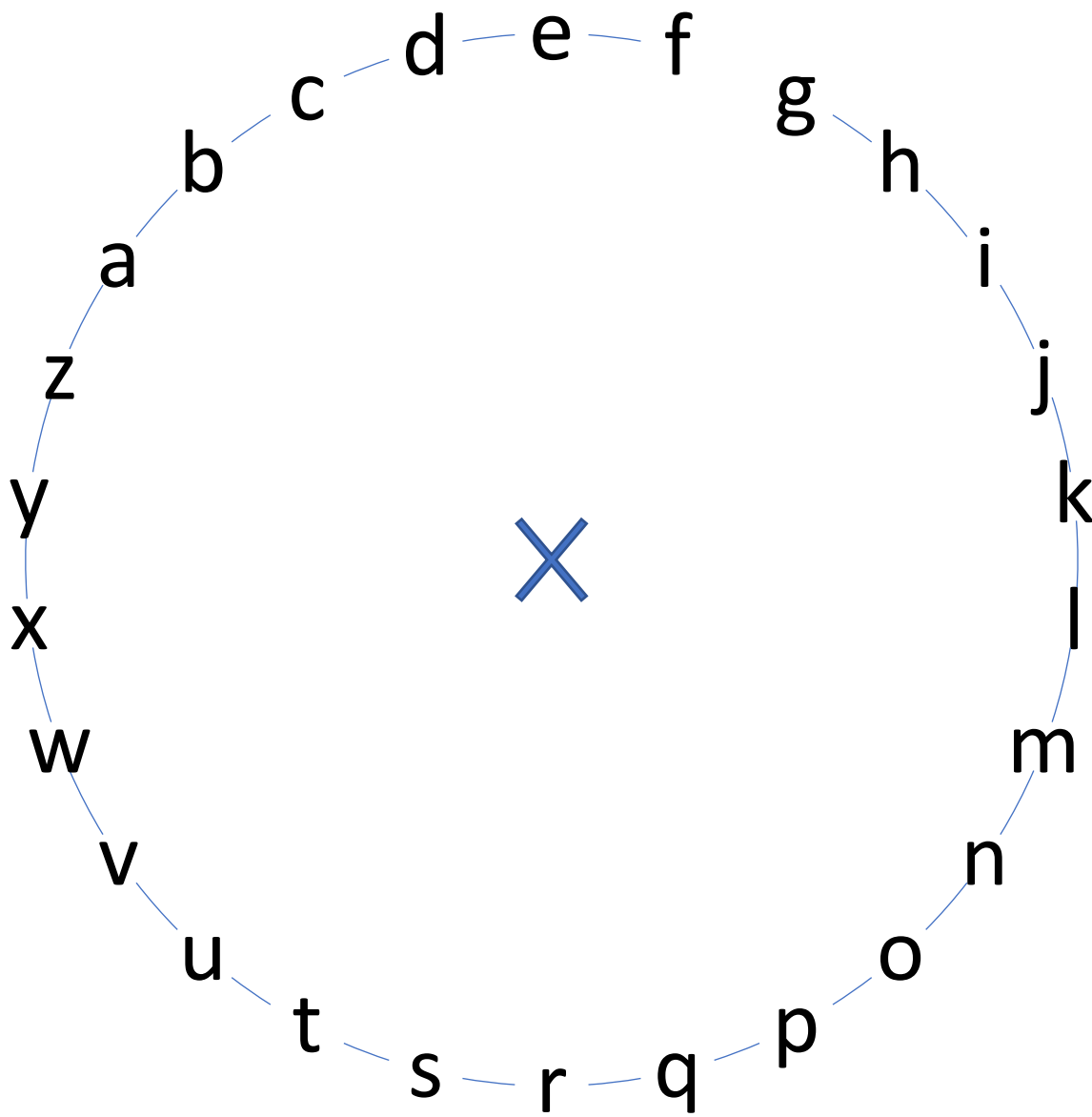

Break the Sad and Happy Code:

With face set to sad:

h x d f r u u f n n y

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j w m k n b j m

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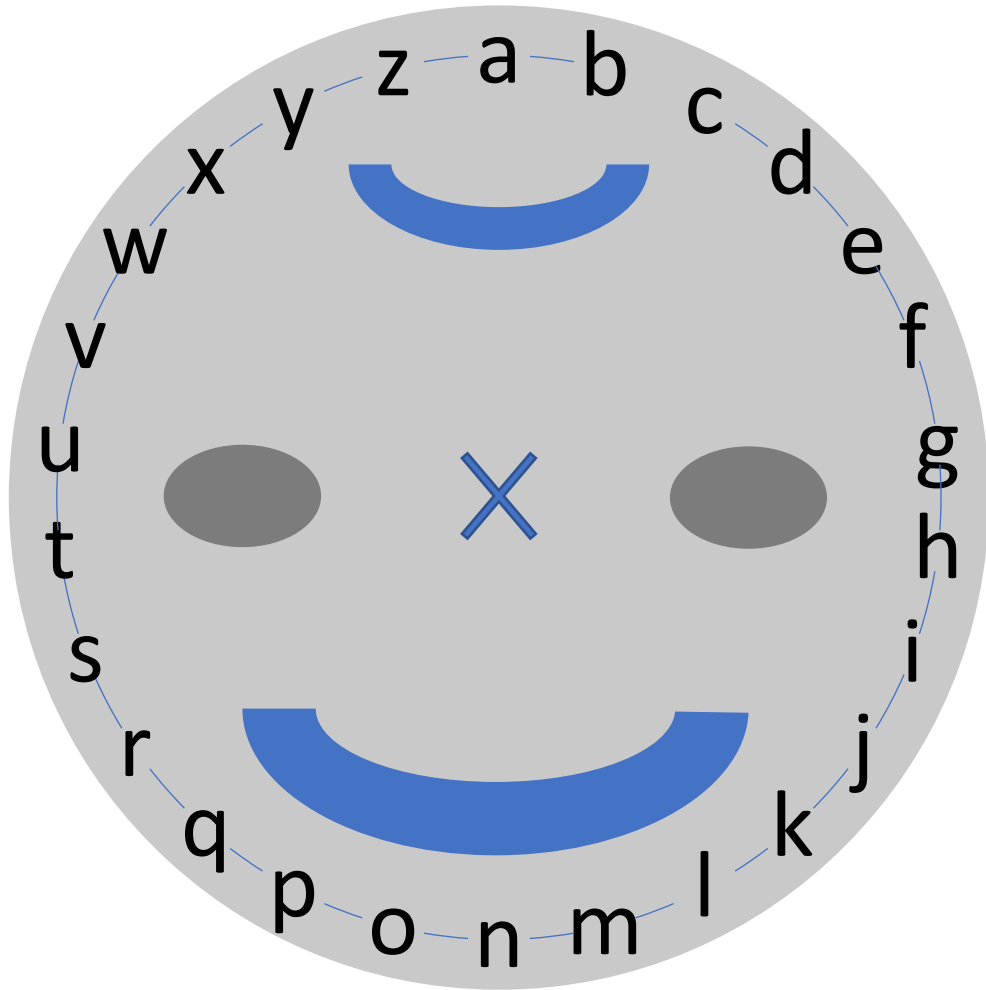
With face set to happy:

x q p u k q n c n e a b

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s e h h p q n j p k f k u.

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Cut out circle and connect to other sheet with a split pin joining them both at the crosses.
