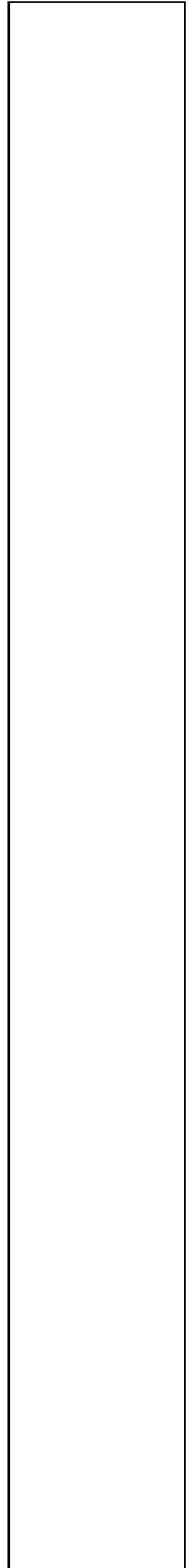


Notes for Parents:

1. This worksheet is based on John 3:14-15, where Jesus uses the story from Numbers 21:4-9 as a way of explaining what the cross achieves.
2. On Sheet 1, colour the snake (right) and the pole (left) alongside the Jesus cross bar (below).
3. Cut out all three elements.
4. Fold along the dotted lines on the snake to create a 'concertina' effect.
5. Stick the snake to the top of the pole on one side and the cross-bar of Jesus on the other side.
6. See if your child can use the craft to retell the story from Numbers 21:4-9 and how it relates to Jesus on the cross.
7. The other sheet provides some activities for older children to help them think through the stories more.
