

## Upcoming Questionnaire on St. George's and St. Luke's

Over the last year St. Luke's and St. George's PCCs have been having discussions about the future shape of mission and ministry in Ramsgate town centre and how the two churches might partner together in that. We have had some very fruitful discussions and considered a wide variety of possible options for the way forward. Now, we need to gather as much information as we can to help us prayerfully discern the best way forward. A key part of that will be a questionnaire that we are hoping all members of both congregations will complete.

We hope to give people the option to either complete the questionnaire online or on a paper form. The questionnaire will seek your views and opinions on a number of different aspects of possible changes, including your views on what to do with the buildings, what style of services to hold and how to organise congregations. Your opinion really matters and so we hope that when the questionnaire comes out at either the end of February or late March you will take the time to fill it in carefully, thoughtfully and prayerfully.
